### Foster Grandparent Program Continuation and Renewal

- Added columns to the Appendix A: FY 2023 NOFA Type, Baseline Funding before Stipend Increase, Federal (Fed.) VSYS, Total of \$.15 Stipend Increase for Fed. VSYS Only, and Baseline Funding update with \$.15 Stipend Increase.
- In FY 2022, quarter 3 grantees only received 9 months of stipend increase. For the FY 2023 application, quarter 3 grantees will receive a full 12-month permanent Baseline Funding Stipend Increase. AmeriCorps Seniors calculated the permanent Baseline Funding stipend increase, by taking the original Baseline Funding (\$XX,XXX) + ((Fed. VSYS (XX) x (\$157)) = Baseline Funding updated with \$.15 Stipend Increase, highlighted in yellow.
  - Note:  $\$0.15 * 1044 = \$156.60$ . Because eGrants doesn't allow decimals, we rounded the amount up to \$157.
