### **Reporting Offset of Disallowed Subrecipient Costs**

We are reviewing the process and guidance for commissions and other grantees with subrecipients to report offset subrecipient costs disallowed on the basis of National Service Criminal History Check noncompliance. We plan to provide updated guidance by the end of March as we ensure the process aligns with AmeriCorps policies. Before issuing final guidance, we will host an information session for commissions and other prime grantees with subrecipients to review the process.

Grantees with subrecipients should continue to report any subrecipient disallowance that requires **repayment** to AmeriCorps, as described in the "Awardee Guide to NSCHC Enforcement of Cost-Based Disallowance" on the <a href="NSCHC webpage">NSCHC webpage</a>.

## **New Single Vendor Contract Awarded**

AmeriCorps has awarded a contract to Truescreen to provide all three check components through one system. In the coming months, Truescreen will work with its sibling company, Fieldprint, to incorporate the FBI check into the existing Truescreen platform. Until the new system is established, you may continue to use Truescreen to conduct National Sex Offender Public Website and state checks and use Fieldprint to conduct FBI checks.

We understand this is a big change for many of you who use the approved vendors. We look forward to hosting information sessions this spring to share updates and receive your feedback for a smooth transition to the updated platform and process.
