

Arizona Food Bank Network

This project utilizes 30 VISTA members to increase the capacity and sustainability of food pantries and bolster local food systems.

- 20+ VISTA members serve at organizations throughout Arizona that align with AmeriCorps'
 Healthy Futures focus areas
- In FY23, VISTA members generated approximately \$490,000 in cash resources; and over \$100,000 of inkind resources



Housing Action Illinois

This project utilizes approximately 20 VISTA members to increase the capacity of nonprofits and public agencies that serve families who are experiencing or are at risk of experiencing housing instability. The program has an emphasis on economic opportunity. In the past program year, VISTA members have:

- Generated over \$700,000 in grants, cash, and in-kind donations.
- Connected 4,000 households with housing services
- Recruited and managed 500 volunteers
- Developed partnerships, tracking systems, sustainable evaluation initiatives, and more



Tasks and activities to expand the scale, reach, efficiency or effectiveness of specific antipoverty projects


Direct Service

Sponsor Responsibilities: Member Management

- Recruit and place VISTA members
- Provide workspace, equipment and supplies
- Professional development and on-site orientation & training
- Assist VISTA members with community entry
- VISTA member supervision and performance appraisals
- Sponsor Verification Form





AmeriCorps VISTA Members





The Basics

- 18+ years of age
- U.S. citizens or legal permanent residents
- Must pass a criminal history review
- May have specific knowledge skills, or abilities required by the sponsoring organization
- Local or national recruits

VISTA Leaders

- Projects with six or more VISTAs may have a Leader assigned to support the members
- Leaders guide data collection & interpret data (they do not perform the reporting)
- Coordinate, facilitate, and support the efforts of VISTA members (do not supervise)





What do **AmeriCorps VISTA** Members do?

<u>Create Powerful Partnerships</u> with businesses, community leaders, and other stakeholders

Expand current programs in demographic, geographic, and/or programmatic scope

Build volunteer management, leadership and training systems

Leverage both cash and in-kind resources by building development systems


AmeriCorps VISTA Concept Paper

Organizations submit an AmeriCorps VISTA Concept Paper. The Concept Paper is a preliminary screening tool used to evaluate whether the organization would be an appropriate sponsor.

2

AmeriCorps VISTA Project Application

If AmeriCorps approves the Concept Paper, the organization submits an AmeriCorps VISTA Project Application based on the approved Concept Paper.

Characteristics of a Strong Concept Paper

- Aligns with AmeriCorps focus areas/VISTA programming priorities
- Addresses the needs of a low-income community
- Involves the community in project development and implementation
- Leads to organizational capacity and sustainability
- Generates public or private sector resources
- Promotes local volunteer service
- Be specific

What makes an AmeriCorps VISTA Project- and application-Successful?

Clearly shows how the capacity building activities you are proposing directly ties into anti-poverty outcomes in the community you're serving

Includes deliberate engagement of your beneficiary population and communities

Is designed with the end in mind – when will your project become selfsustaining and how? With additional staff? Community volunteers? Partnerships with other organizations and agencies?

Focuses not only on the project activities but on the development of members. VISTAs may be younger and in need of greater supervisor or they may be retired community members that can work on their own. As a project director and VISTA Supervisor, you will have to flex your skills to adapt to the people you recruit. It will be worth it in the end!
